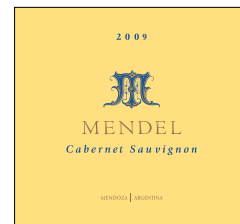

The 2009 Cabernet Sauvignon offers up an alluring bouquet of Asian spices, incense, violets, and black currant. Concentrated, balanced, and full-flavored, it displays both elegance and freshness. It has enough structure to evolve for 2-3 years and will provide prime drinking from 2014 to 2024.

Mendel is a partnership of renowned winemaker Roberto de la Mota and Annabelle Sielecki whose family owns the vineyards. As a postscript, while visiting the winery in October 2011, I was also shown the 2006, 2007, and 2008 vintages of Finca Remota, which have been reviewed before in these pages. They are performing as well or better than I previously reported.
