

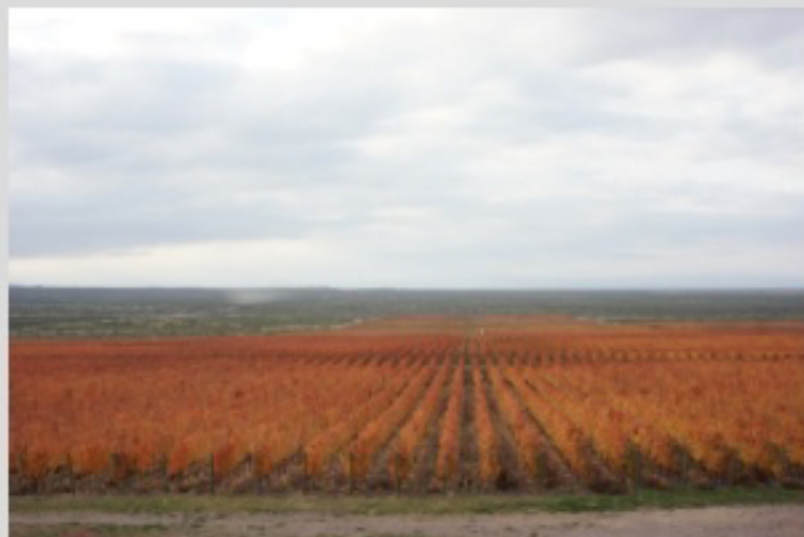
TASTING REPORT:
ARGENTINA'S GREAT MINERALITY
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Weekly Picks

There's a quiet revolution among top Argentine wine producers as they move towards more refined wines, a departure from the usual big and bold reds that consumers often associate with the country.

Among the [600 wines](#) I tasted earlier in April, 2013 and 2012 really stood out. Wines from the two vintages look to be excellent in all regions in Argentina, and the 2014 is less consistent in comparison.



This week, I selected five value wines from the two vintages for you. These are the wines you should watch out for in the market -- be sure to try them.
